

FOURTH PART

Organisation - various (art. 13 - 14)

Art. 13

Choirs are responsible for their own travel, board and lodging and the relevant expenses. Nevertheless, the organisation will give a refund of the expenses (see art. 14).

On request, the Organizing Committee will send a list and addresses of hotels, travel agencies or Institutes settled with the organization of the competition.

Choirs can benefit from board and lodging in a affordable college.

The Organizing Committee will make available a free guide to the choirs who request it.

Art. 14

14.a. The Organizing Committee will provide boarding and lodging **for those choirs with LESS THAN 18 singers (included the conductor).**

All other expenses will be in charge of the choir.

This treatment does not admit other types of contribution to expenses.

14.b. **Choirs with MORE THAN 19 singers (included the conductor)** will receive from the Organizing Committee a contribution for the travel, board and lodging expenses, proportionally to the distance from the home town to the venue of the competition according to the following table:

up	to km 500	EURO 1100,00
from km 501	to km 700	EURO 1600,00
from km 701	to km 900	EURO 2000,00
from km 901	to km 1100	EURO 2400,00
from km 1101		EURO 3000,00

FIFTH PART

(Audio-Video recordings, juridical rules)

A. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to record (audio-visual recordings) any performance given during the competition, even for radiophonic, television and discographic purposes, and for subsequent broadcast on radio/television both in Italy and abroad, without payment to the performing ensembles or their conductors.

B. If strictly necessary, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the articles of these regulations, giving prompt communication to all participants.

C. Participation in the competition implies full knowledge and acceptance of these regulations.

D. For any litigation the place of jurisdiction is Gorizia and the document to take into account is the Italian version of the regulations
